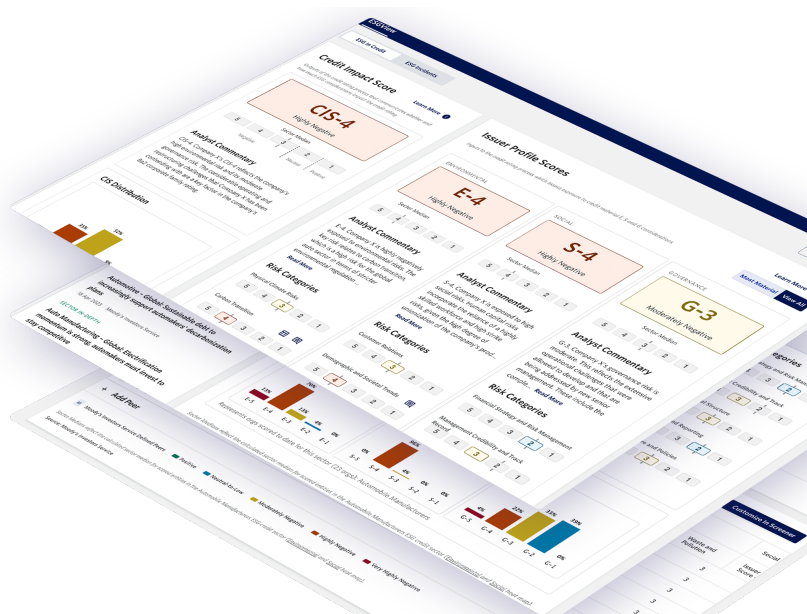
Issuer Profile Score
